

Alpaca Scarf For Wild and Wooly Colorado



Yarn Crawl By Jonna Toth

Supplies used:

Alpaca Yarn Company - Carnival - Colorway 852 Gray
Plymouth Yarn - Baby Alpaca Worsted - Lt Grey Heather
5 yards of Scrap yarn - Black
Fur Pom Pom
Poly Fill

US Size I Crochet Hook
Tapestry needle
Safety Pin type Sitch marker

Glossary:

ch - chain

SC - Single Crochet

Sk - skip

Sc2tog - single crochet 2 stitches together

St - stitch

Hoofs - make 8

Ch2, turn

Row 1 - sk ch, SC1, ch1, turn

Row 2 - sk ch, SC2 into stitch below

Tie off hoof 1, 3, 5 and 7 Cut yarn

On hoof 2, 4, 6 and 8 - ch 1 at end of Row 2, and turn, then continue on with pattern for legs

Legs - make 4

Use even numbered hoof triangles

Row 1 - sk ch, sc2 into hoof top stitches, ch3, attach even numbered hook triangle
sc2, ch1, turn

Rows 2 thru 12 - sk ch, sc7, ch 1, turn

Row 13 - sk ch, sc7, tie off and cut yarn of three of the legs,

Row 13 of fourth leg - sk ch, sc7, ch1, turn and move on to pattern of body.

Body

Row 1 - sc7 across leg, ch 3, attach loose leg, sc7 into leg, ch1, turn

Row 2 - sk ch, sc2 into first st, sc across to last st, sc2 into last st, ch1, turn

Row 3 - sk ch, sc across, ch 1, turn

Row 4 - Repeat Row 2

Row 5 - Repeat Row 3

Row 6 - Repeat Row 2

Row 7 thru 20 - sk ch, sc across, ch1, turn

Row 21 - sk ch, sc2tog, sc to last 2 sts, sc2tog, ch1, turn

Row 22 thru 25 - sk ch, sc across, ch1, turn

Row 26 - Repeat Row 21

Row 27 - sk ch, sc across, ch1, turn

Repeat row 27 to the desired length of the scarf/body part of the piece.

Row 28 - Repeat Row 2

Row 29 thru 31 - Repeat Row 3

Row 32 - Repeat Row 2

Row 33 thru 46 - Repeat Row 3

Row 47 - Repeat Row 21

Row 48 - Repeat Row 3

Row 49 - Repeat Row 21

Row 50 - Repeat Row 3

Row 51 - Repeat 21

Row 52 - sk ch, attach loose leg, sc7 through body and leg, sc 3, attach loose leg, sc7 through body and leg, ch 1, tie off and cut yarn

Ears - make 2

Ch 2

Row 1 - sk ch, sc1, ch1, turn

Row 2 - sk ch, sc2 into same st, ch1, turn

Row 3 - sk ch, *sc2 into same st* a total of 2x, ch1, turn

Row 4 - sk ch, sc1, *sc2 into same st* a total of 2x, sc1, ch1, turn

Row 5 - sk ch, sc1, sc2 into same st, sc2, sc2 into same st, sc1, ch1, tie off cut yarn

Sl st around outer edge of ear triangle

Head

Sc6 into Magic Ring, do not connect first and last sts together with sl st, place safety pin stitch marker at beginning of round

Rnd 1 - sc2 into each st around

Rnd 2 - *sc1, sc2 into next st* repeat around

Rnd 3 - *sc2, sc2 into next st* repeat around

Rnd 4 - sc around

Rnd 5 - *sc3, sc2 into next st* repeat around

Rnd 6 - *sc4, sc2 into next st* repeat around

Rnd 7thru 10 - repeat rnd 4

Tie off and cut yarn

Strap

Ch5

Row 1 - 15 - sk ch, sc4, ch1, turn

Row 16, sk ch, sc4, tie off and cut yarn

Assembly:

Fold and Sew ears onto head/face with triangle pointing up. Then sew the head onto one end of the body/scarf in the space that is wider than the narrow scarf section, stuff the head with Poly Fill when it is sewn almost completely to the scarf. Pull up desired amount of loops between the ears. Stitch facial features to the head. Attach Pom Pom on other end of scarf in the wider space above the legs. Attach strap on back of scarf above the head/face. Slip the tail end of the scarf through the strap to secure the crossover.

Weave in all ends and enjoy wearing your new friend!
